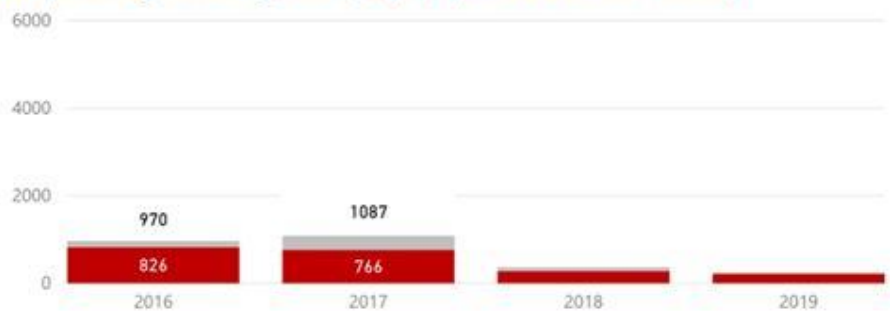

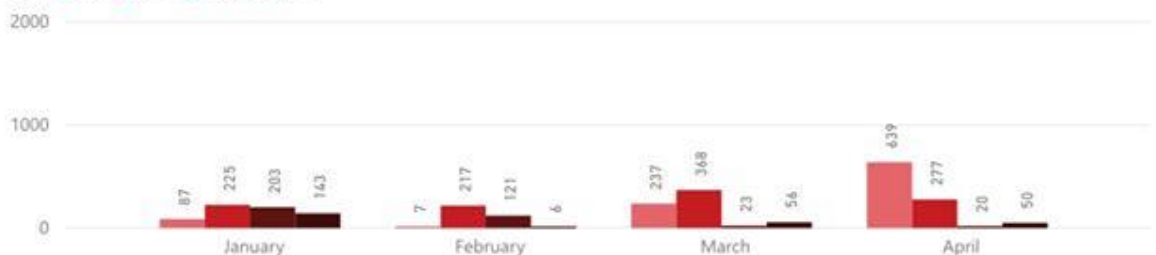

Figures included in the dead and missing file are compiled from a variety of sources, including report from survivors and family members collected by UNHCR staff governments, Coast Guard or Navy vessels. News, Media and Civil Society are also an important source of information. Because of the varying quality and reliability of data, every effort has been made to ensure that all statistical information is verified and focuses on dead and missing at sea represent conservative estimates of a number that could possibly be higher than reported.

I numeri sono numeri. Morti e dispersi in mare secondo l'agenzia dell'ONU nel periodo da gennaio ad aprile:

– Anno 2016, ministro Alfano, politica delle porte aperte e mare sicuro: 970 morti o dispersi.

– anno 2017, ministro Minniti, continua la politica delle porte aperte e mare sicuro: 1087 morti o dispersi.

– anno 2018, ministro Minniti, ci sono le elezioni, la politica è cambiata, si danno soldi ai libici per non fare partire i gommoni: 367 morti o dispersi.

– anno 2019: ministro Salvini, porti chiusi alle ONG: 255 morti o dispersi.

CONCLUSIONE:

1) Il numero assoluto di morti in mare aumenta con le politiche favorevoli all'accoglienza dei barconi e dei gommoni e del sostegno ai soccorsi in mare.

2) Chiunque incoraggi queste politiche favorisce indirettamente la morte delle persone migranti.
